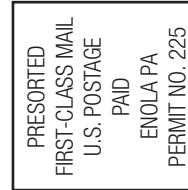

The 2009 International Energy Conservation Code – Achieving 90 Percent Compliance in Residential Occupancies

To secure former federal Recovery Act funding for Pennsylvania, Governor Ed Rendell signed a letter of assurance to the U.S. Secretary of Energy stating that Pennsylvania would achieve 90 percent compliance with target energy codes by 2017. One of these target codes is the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) for residential buildings. Pennsylvania is already a step ahead of many states in that it has adopted the 2009 IECC as a compliance path. However, achieving compliance is more complicated than simply adopting a code – enforcement is the key. This one-day program will provide a review of the residential portions of the 2009 IECC, proper use of ACCA Manual J “Residential Load Calculation” and other useful plan review and inspection information to complement guidance materials provided by the U.S. Department of Energy.

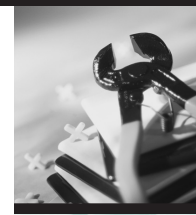
